**POSITION SUMMARY:**

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** The duties listed below are representative of various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position as determined by the Utility Manager. The City of Cumberland retains and reserves any and all rights to change, modify, amend, add or delete from any section of this document as it deems to be proper.

- Operates, maintains, and constructs electric distribution system and other duties as assigned by the Line Foreman and Utility Manager.
- Install and remove overhead and underground wires; secondary, primary and transmission.
- Trimming of tree limbs and branches to allow proper power line clearance.
- Electric meter testing
- Keeps track of materials on each job and prepares proper paperwork.
- Strong understanding and commitment to safety procedures.
- Perform trouble shooting and repairs on the overhead and underground electric system.
- Assists with coordination of vehicle/equipment maintenance and testing.
- Ability to perform strenuous physical labor and heavy manual tasks including climbing and working in all weather conditions. Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Install, remove, operate, and maintain Cumberland Municipal Utility owned streetlighting facilities, including poles, wires, and fixtures.
- Operate and maintain job-related equipment, including but not limited to backhoes, bucket trucks, forklifts, trenchers, cranes, pickups, skid steers, compressors, and faultfinders.
- Clean, restock and prepare trucks for the following workday.
- Skilled in the operation of equipment, tools, and testing equipment.
- Read meters, posts disconnect notices, disconnects, and reconnects customers.
- Perform troubleshooting, power restoration and damage repair duties, when necessary, in a safe, reliable and time efficient manner.
- Plow snow on Utility parcels during the winter months.

- Assists other departments as needed or assigned.
- Participates in on-call duties, with occasional night and weekend duty.

**DESIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** HS diploma or equivalent required. Successful completion of electrical lineman apprenticeship. Hold valid journeyman lineworker certification. Valid WI Driver's License required. Possession or ability to obtain a Class A CDL within 6 months of hire. Basic computer and effective communication skills.
